

## SCS 30/60 - Configuring the System to Meet your Needs

- a. Select the MPA Series required to handle the zones as intended. If more than sixty (60) zones are required, additional groups of thirty (30) or sixty (60) may be added together and interconnected to provide the necessary annunciation to handle all the zones required.
- b. For each Control Annunciator Panel a power supply must be provided, the PS-103.
- c. Zone Communicators are stand-alone MUX units to which twenty (20) receivers may be connected. The stand-alone MUX is provided when the location of the MUX is in an isolated, remote location from any receivers.
- d. The Thirty (30) Zone Relay Output Card (ROC-30) is provided to interconnect other annunciator systems and to provide control for remote devices.
- e. The six (6) Standard RM Receivers are all Combination Receiver/MUXes, and from each an additional nineteen (19) Receiver/MUXes may be connected to provide coverage for a large area if that is necessary. In each case, the Receiver MUX can establish its own individual address. The additional receivers in the RS, MS and WS Series are Standard Receivers that may be connected to the MUX 100 or any Receiver/MUX.
- f. If audio is required for the system, the additional cost is \$125 per MUX with the addition of a twisted pair to handle the audio back to the panel and a \$500 charge for an Amplifier Speaker Unit to provide the audio at the annunciation point. There can be two Audio Receivers per zone.
